

## LAWRENCE POLICE DEPARTMENT MAKES CRASH REPORTS AVAILABLE ONLINE

**Lawrence Police Department, Lawrence MA,** is digitizing its crash reports through a partnership with the Carfax Police Crash Assistance Program. The reports are stored electronically in a secure database and available for purchase online at <a href="https://www.crashdocs.org">www.crashdocs.org</a>. To purchase a report, select the State on the homepage and Lawrence Police Department under the 'I was in an Accident' section and click 'Find a Report'. You will then be taken to a page where you can enter your report number, date of accident and last name to purchase with a credit card and view the report immediately.

As a Corporate Purchaser, you will be granted access to enhanced search features through the site which also provides monthly invoices for report purchasers. No additional fee is charged for this service. To sign up for an account, simply visit our website and click the 'Sign Up Free' button under the Corporate Account login. Once your information is submitted, I will contact you with a username and password so you can start purchasing reports. Additionally, Crashdocs has Customer Service support available to all report purchasers in the event that your report is not found online. We ask that you contact them first through email at:

Crashdocs@carfax.com. They will assist in locating your report or contacting us for a status update. Please note that it takes (typically) 5-7 days from the date of the accident for reports to show up in the system.

Filing electronic crash reports reduces overhead costs for the department. Police departments spend an average of \$35,000 a year to manually reproduce accident reports. The new system virtually eliminates this cost as well as the administrative staff time spent fulfilling each request.
