

**Bellevue Cemetery
Rules and Regulations
Revised 10/1/2024**

- **VISTING HOURS**: Dawn to Dusk. No Trespassing after cemetery closing hours. Violators are Subject to Prosecution.
- Please place all Trash in the Barrels provided by the Cemetery.
- Illegal Dumping is forbidden. Cameras are on the premises.
- All Vehicles Speed Limit 15mph.
- The Washing, Polishing of Vehicles is Strictly Forbidden.
- Recreation Vehicles are Not Permitted in the Cemetery. This includes ATV's, Snowmobiles, Dirt Bikes or Four Wheelers.
- Driving school or practices are not allowed- Strictly forbidden.
- Visitors May Not Park on the Grass, pick flowers, injure trees or shrubs.
- Discharge of Firearms is Strictly Forbidden except at Military Funerals and Municipal Civic Events.
- Applications for Military Funerals and Municipal Civic Events must be filed with the Superintendent.
- Alcohol is not permitted on Cemetery Grounds or Buildings.
- No Eating, Drinking or Recreation Events unless by Special Permit. This includes Track/Road Races, Football, Baseball, Picnics. Special Permits must be obtained from the Superintendent.
- Camping and Erection of Tents is Forbidden, except for Funeral purposes and Municipal Events.
- No Dogs allowed on Cemetery Grounds.
- Enclosures are Strictly Prohibited. This includes: Bricks, Cement Curbing, Stones, Plastic, Plastic Edging, Wire or Wood Fencing, Marble Chips, Mulch and Tiles are prohibited.
- Shrubbery and Plants Must be approved by the Superintendent. All Others Subject to Removal.
- **DECORATIONS**
- Fresh Flowers, and Plantings are Permitted.
- **PHOHIBTED ITEMS**: Live Candles, LED Lighting, Artificial Flowers/Plants; Except over the Monument type, Glass of any kind (Vases, trinkets, statues, etc.), Trellis, Shepherd's, Hooks, Crosses, Beads, Statues, Plaques, Toys, Balloons, Pin Wheels, Personal Items, Stuffed Animals, Trinkets and other Monumental and/or Ornamental Objects.
- Wooden or Ceramic Planters will be removed during the Spring cleanup.
- **Holiday Decorations**: Approved Decorations may be placed one week prior to the following holidays and will be removed one week after the following holiday or the next business day:
- New Year's Day, Valentine's Day

- Easter Memorial Day
- Thanksgiving, Mother's and Father's Day
- Christmas Day***
- *** December Decorations may be placed at Thanksgiving; Wreaths, Baskets and Evergreen Blankets***

DAMAGE: The cemetery shall take reasonable precaution to protect owners, and the property rights of owners, within the Cemetery, from loss or damage, but it distinctly disclaims all responsibility for loss or damage from causes beyond its reasonable control, and especially from damage from caused by the elements, an act of God, common enemy, thieves, vandals, malicious mischief makers, explosion, unavoidable accidents, invasion, insurrections, riots, or any order of military or civil authority, whether the damage be direct or collateral.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: All special instructions should be given in writing to the Superintendent. The work may only be accomplished by Cemetery employees under the direct supervision of the Superintendent.
